

Transcrime is the Joint Research Centre on Innovation and Crime of the Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore, the Alma Mater Studiorum Università di Bologna and the Università degli Studi di Perugia.

The centre, directed by Professor Ernesto Ugo Savona, is based in Milan and has a staff of about 30 people.
Transcrime is exclusively funded by contracts and private

corporations and local, national and international public institutions.

Transcrime is a key supporting body of the education activities provided by the Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore di Milano. In particular, the centre supports the coordination of the Master's degree in Public Policies - curriculum Security Policies (Poli.Si) and the International Ph.D. in Criminology.





